Competition Details

ADS Rules

The Wade House Carriage Driving Days is a recognized by the American Driving Society, Inc. and will follow all the rules of the society unless otherwise stated in this prize list as a *House* rule. You may download a copy of the Rulebook at www.americandrivingsociety.org. The organizers encourage every competitor to be familiar with all the General regulations and the rules for a Pleasure Driving competition, as the Rulebook is updated every year.

Officials

Judge: Ruthie Graves, Texas, ADS Pleasure Driving (R) Registered Judge, (r) Recorded Dressage Judge **Technical Delegate:** Ted Campbell, California, Pleasure Driving (R) Technical Delegate

Divisions

Juniors (Youth who have not reached their 19th birthday in 2022, Article: 2.7), VSE (Very Small Equine), Utility Vehicle, Novice Driver, Novice Pony/Horse, Small Pony, Pony, Horse, Pairs/Multiples. There must be at least 4 entries to make a division. Utility Tires/Wheels: The use of pneumatic tires is permitted only in the Utility Vehicle division classes. The use of wire wheels is permitted for VSE equines only in any class they may enter.

Entries

An entry is defined as a combination of horse(s), vehicle and driver and must be assigned a specific entry number. Organizers of recognized events may limit entries, refuse any entry, cancel, combine or divide a class, alter the proposed time schedule or substitute officials if necessary. (Article: 1.7) Entries mailed to Secretary: Rachel Meek

Ribbons and Trophies

Ribbons for 1st - 5th place ribbons per class. Championship and Reserve ribbons per each division. Championships will be awarded based on the following points system. $1^{st} = 6$, $2^{nd} = 4$, $3^{rd} = 3$, $4^{th} = 2$, $5^{th} = 1$. Ties will be broken based on ADS Rules (Article: 217) Championships will be awarded based on the 6 division classes.

House Rules

Wade House Cross Country: TBA, due to the logging activities on the grounds at the time the writing of this document we are unsure if we will be able to hold any cross country classes.

Antique Driver or Antique Horse: Either the horse has to be 18 older or the driver has to be 65 or older. Special consideration by the judges for any turnout that meets BOTH requirements. Judge on 50% Working and 50% on Reinsmanship.

Antique Vehicle: Can be a restored or an original vehicle made before 1950. Class will be judged as a Turnout class.

Best in Show: Entry for this class is by invitation of the Judge. The judge will evaluate all the turnouts he or she has examined on Saturday to choose the one entry he or she feels is the BEST at the show. Winner is completely determined by the judges opinion.
