Competition Details

New for 2025

- The cones classes have been moved to a new location.
- There will be a Cocktail Hour (with cash bar) and tours of Wesley W. Jung Carriage Museum followed by dinner in the Walnut Room on Saturday evening. Tickets are \$35/person.
- The Combined Test will be conducted under the Combined Driving Rules (Art. 901.10.5).
- 1st-5th place ribbons will be awarded in the CT and Pleasure Show.

ADS Rules

The Wade House Carriage Driving Days is recognized by the American Driving Society, Inc. and will follow all the rules of the society unless otherwise stated in this prize list as a *House* rule. You may download a copy of the Rulebook at <u>www.americandrivingsociety.org</u>. The organizers encourage every competitor to be familiar with all the General regulations and the rules for a Pleasure Driving competition, as the Rulebook is updated every year.

Divisions

Juniors (Youth who have not reached their 19th birthday in 2025, (Article: 2.7), VSE (Very Small Equine), Utility Vehicle*, Novice Driver, Novice Pony/Horse, Small Pony, Pony, Horse, Pairs/Multiples. There must be at least 4 entries to make a division.

*Please enter the Utility Vehicle Division (House Rules Definition) if you have a vehicle primarily designed for marathon or more heavy-duty use. Utility vehicles may not enter non-divisional classes, etc. Utility vehicles are welcomed in Junior, Novice Horse, Novice Pony, and Novice Driver Divisions.

Tires/Wheels

Pneumatic tires permitted only in Utility division classes. The use of wire wheels is permitted for VSE equines only in any class they may enter. Antique Vehicles (Art. 206.2).

Divisional Classes

Turnout (Article 217), Working (Article 218), Reinsmanship (Article 222), Pleasure Drive – Pace (Article 260), Progressive (Article 249.2), and My route/Your Route (Article 248.6).

Please note: The cones classes have been moved to a new location for the 2025 competition.

Non-Divisional Classes

Carriage Dog (Article 231), Drive & Ride (Article 227 Walk/Trot), Ladies' Driving Class (Article 219), Gentlemen's Driving Class (Article 220), Concours D'Elegance (Article 230).

Concours D'Elegance: Entry for this class is by invitation of the Judge. The judge will evaluate all turnouts examined on Saturday and invite selected turnouts to the ring for a class shown both directions of the ring at several gaits. The judge will then choose the one entry he or she feels is the BEST at the show. Winner is completely determined by the judge's opinion.

Combined Test

The Combined Test will begin at Noon on Friday, July 11. The Combined Test is limited to 24 competitors. Competitors will compete using the following tests: Training Level: ADS 2020 Training Test B Preliminary Level: ADS 2020 Preliminary Test B Intermediate Level: ADS 2020 Intermediate Test B

Entries

An entry is defined as a combination of horse(s), vehicle and driver and must be assigned a specific entry number. Organizers of recognized events may limit entries, refuse any entry, cancel, combine or divide a class, alter the proposed time schedule or substitute officials if necessary. (Article: 1.7)

Ribbons and Trophies

Ribbons for 1st – 5th place ribbons per class. Championship and Reserve ribbons per each division. Championships will be awarded based on the following points system. $1^{st} = 6$, $2^{nd} = 4$, $3^{rd} = 3$, $4^{th} = 2$, $5^{th} = 1$. Ties will be broken based on ADS Rules (Article: 216.3). Pleasure Championships will be awarded based on the 6 divisional classes. Combined Test – 1^{st} - 5^{th} Place ribbons will be awarded for each level (Training, Preliminary, Intermediate) with no further division by turnout (i.e. singles, multiples, etc).

House Rules Classes

Antique Vehicle: Can be a restored or an original vehicle made before 1950. Class will be judged as a Turnout class.

Antique Driver or Antique Horse: Either the horse has to be 18 years or older or the driver has to be 65 years or older. Special consideration by the judges for any turnout that meets BOTH requirements. Judged on 50% Working and 50% on Reinsmanship.

Drivers must attend one of the meetings. **Saturday Evening Dinner:** Cocktail Hour (with cash bar) and tours of Wesley W. Jung Carriage Museum followed by dinner in the Walnut Room. **Awards Party:** Sunday, one hour after last class.

Full refund only with Vet or Doctor's certificate less \$50 after the closing date. **Golf Cart:** \$215 for a single seat. Rental fees can be in your entry/stall check. **Stall Fee:** \$175 per horse. Limited shavings available \$10/bag – order on registration form. **Tack Stalls:** \$175 per stall.
